- 3. Other special services as needed (Ash Wednesday, Wednesday Lenten services, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Thanksgiving Eve, Christmas Eve, etc.)
- 4. Must be able to read 4-part open choral score
- 5. Ability to play the piano on occasion.
- 6. Work well with a staff of 7.
- 7. Compensation commensurate with experience.

Please Note:

- 1. If asked to come for an interview/audition, please bring one or two pieces to play. You may also be asked to sight-read a piece.
- 2. Weddings and Funerals are paid separate from the Organist position.

The Instruments:

- The organ is a 3-manual Rodgers 950 with a PR-300S MIDI Connection. Not counting any MIDI sounds, the organ ranks themselves are equivalent to 53 speaking stops. However, it has an 80-voice palette capability because several of the stops can be reassigned as alternate ranks of sound depending upon literature or preference.
- 2. The piano is a Yamaha 6' grand.
